Did you know....

- ⇒ 80 new businesses have opened since Jan. 2015!
- ⇒ Sales tax is the largest revenue source in the General Fund and finances the majority of City services
- ⇒ 58% of all households in the City of Madison have an income greater than \$75,000, with a city-wide average of \$107,330
